Llewelyn Lewis Rowland was born in 1911 and came up to Jesus College in 1931, having been educated at Cardiff High School and University College Cardiff. He seems to have been only at Jesus College for a year, and left without a degree. However, he had presumably done a first degree at Cardiff.

It is not known when Rowland died, but his niece and her husband presented these two photographs to the College's archives in October 2005 as Accession No. 46 (correspondence on the donation may be found in OM ENQ 24).
