JC:P7 PHOTOGRAPH INCLUDING JOSEPH HUCKWELL (MATR. 1878)

Joseph James Huckwell, the eldest son of John of Palla, near Cardiff, gent., came up to Jesus College in 1878 as a Scholar. He was a Mathematics Teacher at Westminster School for many years. It is not known how this photograph came to the archives of Jesus College, where it was found in the summer of 2016, but it presumably came from Huckwell himself or his family.

Photograph of masters at Westminster School, 1909. The photograph is undated and uncaptioned, but several sitters have signed their names in pencil, not always legibly. Names that can be read include F. F. Burrell, S. H. Day, W. G. Etheridge, Avery [?] H. Forbes, G. L. Fox, B. F. Hardy, H. A. Hatton, J. J. Huckwell, A. C. Liddell, G. H. Noble, J. F. Smedley and J. Tyson. Of this group, Joseph James Huckwell matriculated from Jesus College in 1878.

Frank Burrell, Samuel Day, Benjamin Hardy, and Alfred Liddell were recorded in *Alumni Cantabrigenses* as having been Assistant Masters at Westminster School at the same time between 1903 and 1913. Furthermore a webpage from the archives of Westminster School [http://tanner.westminster.org.uk/?page_id=23; checked 15 Sep 2016] includes a reproduction of this same photograph which is captioned "The Masters Election 1909". The website also notes that Huckwell taught Maths at Westminster at this time.
