JC:PI33 MUSICAL EPHEMERA OF WILLIAM DYFRI REES (MATR. 1934)

William Dyfri Rees came up to Jesus College in 1934. These documents all comprise programmes for concerts given by the Jesus College Musical Society (of which Rees was President in 1937) between 1934 and 1938. They were given to the Archives by his daughter in March 2003 as Accession No. 1.

Performers included Isolde Menges (violin), Clifford Curzon (piano), John Milne (flute), and an unnamed chamber orchestra conducted by Trevor Harvey. This concert included the first performance in Oxford of Britten's *Simple Symphony*.
