JC:PI56 PAPERS OF JOHN DUGDALE TURNER (MATR. 1933)

John Dugdale Turner (1913-67) came up to Jesus College in 1933, and read History. He worked for many years in Tanganyika (now Tanzania).

These documents were presented to the College by his daughters in May 2018 as Accession No. 473. They comprise photographs and some dinner menus. Turner was much involved in the Jesus Dramatic Society, being its President in Trinity Term 1935, and the papers include a photograph and two dinner menus relating to that Society.

The memorabilia relating to the Jesus Dramatic Society often includes an elephant. It is not known why this animal (otherwise unknown at the College) was adopted by this society at this time.

Photograph of a group of men (presumably Jesus students and some friends) seated having a meal in a garden. Turner is seated fourth from the right. The purpose of the dinner is unknown, but in the centre of the group is an elephant which was the mascot of Fremlins Ale, and seems to have been adopted by the Jesus Dramatic Society.

Photograph of a group of men seated having a dinner in an unidentified room. A menu visible on the table shows that this was the dinner held to celebrate the Jesus Dramatic Society's production of *The Birds*, held in Lincoln Hall. A copy of the menu is at **JC:PI56/XI/3**. "Lincoln Hall" appears to be a small room, and may not be the Hall of Lincoln College.

Dinner menu for the annual feast of the Elizabethane Society, with inscriptions from some of those present. Turner had finished his degree by now, and appears to have been about to leave for Tanganyika, because the menu includes several jokey references to his new home.
