- **All** UK students may apply for a loan to cover the **tuition fee**. This part of the loan is paid **directly to the University** on your behalf. Fee loan arrangements for EU students commencing their studies in 2021 have not yet been confirmed by the UK government.
- UK students may also apply for a **maintenance loan**.

GRANTS AND BURSARIES

The amount of financial support available depends on 'residual household income'. You can apply for financial support at the same time as you apply through UCAS (from 1 September 2020).

For UK/EU students. There is no separate application form to fill in – the University will use your Student Finance assessment. Remember to tick the box giving consent for your household income to be shared with your university.

If you are a Care Leaver (have been in care for more than 3 months) or an Estranged Student, you will be provided with an additional non-repayable bursary of £3,000.

Oxford Bursaries are paid to you by the College.

3) Jesus College Access Bursaries [see www.jesus.ox.ac.uk/admissions/finance#undergradbursaries]

Available to eligible **UK** students **in addition to** the Oxford Bursaries, these are free grants towards course-related costs. There is no separate application form to fill in – the College will use your Student Finance assessment. Access Bursaries are paid to you by the College.

COSTS

TUITION FEES

- **UK Students**

£9,250 for the academic year 2020-21. Students may pay this tuition fee up front, or defer the costs by adding the fee to their **Student Loan**, in which case the amount will be paid back **after graduation**, when the student is earning over £26,575 (England) at a rate of 9%. While you are studying, interest is the inflation rate plus 3%. Once you have left your course, your interest rate depends on your income in the previous tax year.

A graduate on a salary of £28,800 will pay back £16.69 per month (income is £2,225 over the income threshold; 9% of £2,225 is £200.25 per year; which results in £16.69 per month).

- **Overseas (non-EU) students**

Overseas students pay a tuition fee, known as the **University Composition Fee**, which depends on the course taken. Fees for 2020/21 are:

£27,285 - £36.065 Clinical medicine fees will be significantly higher for Overseas and Islands students

LIVING COSTS

The University of Oxford has calculated that the **living cost** (9 months) for a UK student in Oxford in 2020/21 will be at least **£10,215 per year**. Overseas students should allow more to stay during the vacations.

At **Jesus College**, specific costs are as follows (2020/21 figures):

Accommodation

- Study Bedroom in College or in Ship Street Centre
£24.66 per night = **£4,661** (including bills) for 27 weeks
- College-owned shared flat at one of our annexe sites
£19.14 per person per night = **£5,359** (excluding bills) for 40 weeks

Food

- breakfast (continental) £2.50 (average)
- self-service two-course lunch/dinner £4.55 (average)
- Formal Hall (3-course dinner) £6.80

Meals in Hall are optional. College flats have self-catering facilities.

Students pay a Hall Charge: £75.69 per term in College / £37.85 in flats

Cost per year = **£1,950** if all meals taken during term (27 weeks)
