Teaching duties	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To organise and deliver the physics teaching in the following topics: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ 2nd year electromagnetism (4 problem sets in Michaelmas Term) ○ 2nd year optics (4 problem sets in Hilary Term) ○ 1st year electromagnetism (4 problem sets in HT, plus one in Trinity) • To provide one revision session, or office hours, per topic in Trinity term. • To mark one set of collections (internal college exams) for each topic. Collections marks must be entered in OxCORT/TMS by 4th week of term.
Associated duties	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To meet the Physics Tutors and the Physics Undergraduates in 0th week of each term to confirm arrangements for the term's work. • To liaise with the academic office and other physics tutors about any pastoral problems arising amongst the undergraduates. • To provide relevant information on the students' academic progress to the Governing Body where appropriate, and write termly reports on the performance of the undergraduates in OxCORT/TMS. • To attend the physics sessions of Principal's collections on Thursday or Friday of 8th week, where relevant. • To participate in the annual undergraduate admissions exercise, if required. • To recommend suitable physics textbooks for purchase by the library. • To attend the schools dinner (end of Trinity) and physics dinner (end of Hilary), and the start of year dinner (beginning of Michaelmas), as invited.
