This photograph is undated, but a copy of it is reproduced in the 2000 issue of the *Jesus College Record* on page 48, where it is dated to about 1948. A letter from D. Hywell Davies (now at OM Enq/8 Buitenhuis) dates the occasion to Michaelmas 1947, and identifies the sitters as follows:
