

Jesus College IT – A Quick Guide

Oxford Single Sign-On (SSO) Account

Oxford University IT Services should have already provided you with a college email address and 'Oxford' username which are known as your Single Sign-On (SSO) details. Your SSO credentials allow you to access a wide range of university services with one login.

If you already have an SSO from a previous college or department, you will continue using that account and will not receive a new one beginning with "jesu."

You will need to activate your SSO account before you arrive and the University's IT Services department should have sent you detailed instructions on how to do this. The SSO is used to access a wide variety of services at Oxford and you will be unable to function as a student without it. In addition to your SSO, you'll also receive a Jesus College account in the same format, but with a separate password. This account authorises you to access college computing facilities.

Please note: You must be connected to a university network for the reset password facility to be reachable. This include Eduroam, MWS-Devices, and JC-WiFi.

Jesus College Intranet

You can use the College intranet to access Online Services to book meals in hall, make online payments to the College, book meeting rooms etc. Use this link to access Online Services and enter your Single Sign-On details when prompted: https://intranet.jesus.ox.ac.uk/online-services.

College Networks & WiFi Access

JC-WiFi

The College runs its own JC-WiFi network which is available throughout the Turl Street, Ship Street, Herbert Close, Stevens Close and Woodstock Road buildings. It's an advanced WiFi network where everyone gets their own individual password, and devices which are connected with the same password are able to "see" one another over the WiFi. This means that from your point of view it behaves just like a home WiFi network, and you are able to add all sorts of devices such as printers, Playstations, Sonos audio speakers in exactly the same way that you would at home.

All Freshers will receive their individual JC-WiFi password via email to their Jesus College mailbox shortly before 0th week. This unique password is all you need to connect to the network. Please do not share it with anyone, as any activity carried out using your credentials is your responsibility. If you haven't received your JC-WiFi password, then please check your junk mail folder.

The email should look similar to the example below.



MWS- Devices

The MWS-Devices is managed by the University. This service is for you to use with a personal key which you can use with your own devices, including printers, gaming device and smart TV stick etc.

Eduroam

The College also provides the Eduroam and Cloud networks within its buildings – if you already have an Eduroam account from another educational institute then this should allow you to connect. If you'd like to create an Eduroam account then you can do so here (SSO login required):

The Cloud Network

The Cloud is a public-access WiFi network, also available in shops, pubs, and other businesses across the UK. You can create an account instantly using any email address, which may be helpful when you first arrive, especially if you haven't yet activated your SSO or received your JC-WiFi login details. There is no charge for using The Cloud within the College.

Printing & Webprint Access

We use the Papercut Webprint system for student printing – log in to the Webprint portal with your College account. Full details can be found on the Webprint Intranet page here: https://intranet.jesus.ox.ac.uk/it/college-network/printing

Remote Access (VPN)

Many University services are not available unless you're connected on a University or College network. To enable staff and students to use these services from home, a Virtual Private Network facility is provided, which will allow your laptop or other device to connect securely and the access these services.
